Tree snakes: various species that feed on small mammals and birds	Poison arrow frog: feeds on insects	Cecropia tree: produces large flowers and fruits
Harpy eagle: eats large animals that live in trees	Heleconia: plant with large green leaves and flowers rich in nectar	Beetle: feeds on a wide variety of plants
Fig tree: provides nutritious fruits, only pollinated by specialized wasps	Bats: various species that feed on insects, nectar, and frogs	Fig wasp: pollinates fig flowers and feeds on fig fruit
Toucan: a large bird that feeds on fruits, eggs, and some small animals	Mosquitoes: various species that can feed on most other animals but not spiders.	Orb spider: feeds on many different insects
Giant anteater: feeds on ants and termites	Howler monkey: feeds on tree leaves and some fruit	Ocelot: wild cat that feeds on mammals and birds
Banana: has large leaves, sweet flowers and fruit	Termite: feeds on dead wood from most kinds of trees. Remain hidden from most predators	Lily: produces flowers with nectar
